

Shingle Recycling Facts

- 80% of homes in the US have asphalt shingle roofs
- 10 million tons of shingle tear-offs sent to landfill each year are
 :
 - 5% of landfill volume
 - Easily recycled into paving
- Green Building Standards give credits for it...LEED, NAHB, etc.
- Cost of disposal to contractors likely to increase
- 50% of homeowners say that recycling their torn-off shingles has an importance of 8 on a scale of 1-10

Shingle Recycling Process

















Shingles and Asbestos




- Small amounts of asbestos fibers were used in shingles as late as 1982
- Asbestos has been detected in roughly 1% of shingles brought to the recycling centers
